

## MESSAGE FROM THE FACILITY DIRECTOR

CORE's highest priority is to maintain the Brooklyn House Residential Reentry Center as a safe and secure environment, free from inappropriate conduct of all kinds, including prohibited and/or illegal sexual conduct, sexual harassment or sexual abuse for all staff, volunteers, contractors, visitors and residents.

After an extensive and comprehensive auditing process, the Brooklyn House facility has been determined to be in full compliance with the PREA Standards.

For the period January 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015, Brooklyn House's work to ensure compliance with our zero-tolerance policy was successful with no allegations of sexual misconduct by or among the residents and staff. Annual Training was conducted in April 2015. PREA Policies and Procedures were updated in 2015 to articulate specific policies and procedures designed to prevent prohibited and/or illegal sexual conduct (broadly defined) by or among the staff and residents of the Brooklyn House Residential Reentry Center, and/or address such behavior should it occur, including taking any steps necessary to protect the safety of staff or residents. It is imperative that the safety of the residents and staff is maintained.
